ADVANCED REGISTRATION DEADLINES

Registration will take place January 01 – February 15, **2023**. Please take note of the important dates listed on the following page.

COMPOSITION CLASSES ADDED (2019)

Compositions Classes have been added in the Strings and Guitar categories. There will be three levels in each discipline, Beginner, Intermediate and Senior. Please look in the syllabus under these sections to find the proper class number.

STRINGS CATEGORY NOW DIVIDED BY AGE AND LEVEL (2019)

All Solo Violin, Viola and Cello Classes will now be divided by age and level of study. Level 1 will be Suzuki Book 1 Twinkle-Perpetual Motion, or equivalent. Level 2 will be Suzuki Book 1 Andantino – end of Book 1, or equivalent. Level 3 will be Suzuki Book 2 or equivalent. Level 4 will be Suzuki Book 3 or higher or equivalent. Please check the syllabus carefully to make sure you are registering in the right class. If you are uncertain please contact the coordinator.

VOICE AGE CATEGORIES ADDED

Age categories added to many voice sections. Check carefully for new age groups of 4 and under, 6 and under, and in self-accompanied 14 and under and 12 and under.

AWARDS

The awards section will not be updated until after the registration has closed. Most of the awards are subject to change based on entries. Once entries have been confirmed awards will be announced. There will be multi-discipline awards, the criteria will be: at least two different disciplines, one solo in at least two disciplines and one ensemble in at least one discipline. Example 1: piano solo and duet, violin solo. Example 2: voice solo, piano solo and concert band. Please indicate in notes when registering, if you would like to be considered for these awards.

ADJUDICATORS

We will be offering in person adjudication this year. There are competitive and non-competitive classes. You will have the option of virtual adjudication if preferred, however your students will have limited award opportunities.

SCHEDULING

THE FESTIVAL COORDINATOR WILL:

- determine the order in which classes are scheduled
- subdivide classes if there are many entrants registered for one class
- email a preliminary schedule to teachers for proofreading March 15
- receive corrections from teachers by March 22
- try to accommodate performers with unforeseen conflicts
- not be held responsible for entries made in the wrong class

TEACHERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- reviewing the preliminary schedule and ensuring all information recorded is accurate and complete
- providing corrections to the Festival Coordinator by emailing nbkfestivalofmusic@gmail.com by the March 22nd deadline
- informing all participants of their performance time, date and place

Teachers with 10+ entries in the festival will receive a free program

REGISTRATION

TEACHERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- finding repertoire from the RCM or ConCan syllabi listings (<u>www.rcmusic.ca/syllabi</u> downloadable)
- referring to the syllabus for specific class numbers and titles
- printing a registration form (attached) for each participant
- entering the appropriate class number, description, piece title, composer and duration of piece in minutes and seconds (e.g. 1.15 is one minute and 15 seconds) - Please do not enter pieces as To Be Determined (TBD)

PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- ensuring all information is complete and accurate (DOB must be accurate or scheduling errors occur)
- noting any anticipated scheduling conflicts or accessibility requests
- having a method of payment ready (Credit Card or PAYPAL) prior to registering online
- registering and paying online by the deadline Friday, February 15th
- making all entries with a single transaction payment (to avoid unnecessary service charges)

THE FESTIVAL COORDINATOR WILL:

- not accept registrations or special requests past the deadline (Feb 15th)
- not refund entry fees past the registration deadline
- make arrangements necessary for venue accessibility and/or other special requests
- try to make accommodations for participants with anticipated conflicts (i.e. students who may have exams, university auditions or interviews)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

TEACHERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING ALL PARTICIPANTS, PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OUTLINED BELOW

1) MANAGEMENT

- 1.1 The 57th Annual North Bay Kiwanis Music Festival is under the management of the Festival Committee of the Kiwanis Club of Nipissing, hereinafter called "The Committee" and manages the Festival Coordinator
- 1.2 The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend and interpret any rule for the good of the Festival
- 1.3 Matters which are not covered within these rules, as well as any complaints or protests, are to be referred, in writing, to the Festival Coordinator or to The Committee
- 1.4 The Committee reserves the right to reschedule if necessary at no loss to the participant
- 1.5 The decisions of The Committee and/or the Festival Coordinator are final and binding
- 1.6 The Committee is not responsible for the loss of, or damage to, articles or persons at any venue

2) ACCOMPANISTS

- 2.2 When required, participants must provide their own accompanists
- 2.3 Accompaniment is required for all vocal classes, unless it is an a cappella arrangement
- 2.4 Accompaniment is strongly suggested for instrumental classes

3) MEMORIZATION

- 3.1 Memorization is compulsory for solo classes for all disciplines unless otherwise stated in the syllabus
- **3.2** Memorization is optional for solo classes in all school band instruments including brass, woodwind and percussion
- 3.3 If memorization is compulsory and the music is used, the adjudicator will provide comments but no mark will be given

4) COPYRIGHT

- 4.1 Each participant must have an original copy of their music for all performances
- **4.2** It is unlawful to copy any portion of music or text without authorization from the copyright holder and is a violation of the Canadian Copyright Act
- **4.3** Frederick Harris Music grants permission to festival participants to photocopy single pages from their publications to facilitate page turns (2015 Piano Syllabus p.99)
- 4.4 Allow 6 to 8 weeks for music delivery as providers are often out of stock and require special orders
- 4.5 Under the direction of the Canadian Copyright Act, accompanists must:
 - A) Ensure that an original is visibly placed on the piano when using a photocopy for accompanying purposes OR B) Contact the publisher well in advance of the Festival for written consent to use a one-time photocopy and present the letter to the Chairperson prior to the performance. Make sure the publisher is aware that one book has already been purchased. Destroy after usage at Festival.

ELIGIBILITY IS BASED ON THE HONOUR SYSTEM, HOWEVER, PARTICIPANTS NOT COMPLYING WITH THE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED

5) DATE ADMISSIBILITY

- **5.1** To qualify for a class in which a grade level is set the participant must not perform below the grade they studied as of December 31, 2022.
- 5.2 In classes where an age limit is set, participants must be under the age set as of December 31, 2022.
- **5.3** Performers studying with an adjudicator during the current Festival year (September 1 to June 30) are not eligible to participate in classes judged by that adjudicator
- **5.4** All performances and competitions, unless otherwise stated, will be open to any performer without regard to residence or domicile.

6) CLASS ENTRIES

- 6.1 A participant may not perform the same piece in more than one class
- **6.2** A participant may enter only once in each class but may act as an accompanist for another entrant in the same class (Duet "secondos" are not considered accompanists)
- 6.3 Duets/trios/ensembles members can play more than once in a class provided it is a different instrument

7) SUBSTITUTIONS

- 7.1 If a solo competitor is unable to perform no one may take their place
- **7.2** Substitutions of participants in group sessions must be approved by the Festival Coordinator and must comply with the rules for that class

8) GROUPS

- 8.1 Conductors may be either amateur or professional and may conduct for several entries
- **8.2** Groups may include professionals if they are bona fide members. All ensembles, orchestras, choirs and bands should consist of only bona fide members (i.e. those who regularly rehearse with the group)

9) PIECE SPECIFICS

- 9.1 "Own Choice" selections cannot be changed without the consent of the Festival Coordinator
- 9.2 "Own Choice" participants must wait 3 years to perform the same piece
- **9.3** "Quick Studies" are selected by the adjudicator. The Festival Coordinator will deliver the music to the student's teacher 48 hours prior to performing

10) TRANSPOSITIONS

10.1 Key transpositions are allowed in all voice classes

ONLINE REGISTRATION PROVIDES CONSENT TO THE COMMITTEE, FOR THE NAME AND/OR PHOTOGRAPH AND DETAILS OF ACHIEVEMENT OF EACH PARTICIPANT TO BE DISPLAYED AND/OR PUBLISHED FOR RECOGNITION AND AFFIRMATION PURPOSES, WITHOUT RESTRICTIONS, WITHOUT LIABILITY, AND WITHOUT RENUMERATION TO THE PERFORMER. PLEASE CONTACT THE FESTIVAL COORDINATOR FOR EXCEPTIONS.

11) TIMING

- 11.1 Classes may start ahead of schedule providing all participants are present and agree to start
- 11.2 Participants who do not perform within five minutes of being called will be disqualified
- 11.3 At adjudicators discretion, repeats are allowed for beginner pieces (one minute time limit)
- 11.4 The time limit is seven minutes for all Grade 10 and ARCT classes (unless otherwise stated). For longer piece, please contact the Festival Coordinator

12) ADJUDICATION STANDARDS

- 12.1 Adjudicators are governed by the following standards to preserve a high standard of performance
- 12.2 The marks outlined below are minimum marks only for each standing (A first, second and third place may be awarded with marks of 85%, 83% and 80% respectively)
- 12.3 If the marks below are not obtained, awards will be withheld regardless of the number of entries
- 12.4 Only ONE first place standing can be designated
- 12.5 2nd and 3rd place can be tied
- 12.6 Classes that have been subdivided will each receive first, second and third standings
- 12.7 All participants will receive a certificate and ribbon

13) MARKS

- 13.1 Marks are given out of 100%
- 13.2 Decimal points can be used
- 13.3 Announced at the adjudicator's discretion
- 13.4 Not announced for Band and Choir Standings

14) ADJUDICATOR COMMENTS

- 14.1 Participants who are registered in an incorrect class will receive adjudicator comments only
- 14.2 Performers in the "Non-competitive" class will receive adjudicator comments only

STUDENTS ARE JUDGED BY AN OBJECTIVE STANDARD FOR THE PIECE THEY PERFORM AND NOT JUDGED 'AGAINST' EACH OTHER

- 15.1 The Festival Coordinator will notify all teachers of award winners
- 15.2 The Festival Computer Software Program calculates the winner of the Multi-Discipline Award
- 15.3 A mark of 85% or higher is required to be eligible for cash awards
- 15.4 Grade 10 and ARCT students up to age 25 will be eligible for awards
- 15.5 No adult shall receive any cash award
- 15.6 In categories with less than three participants cash awards may be withheld
- **15.7** Performances rescheduled after the registration deadline will be adjudicated and marked but not eligible for awards

PERFORMERS WITHOUT ORIGINAL MUSIC WILL BE DISQUALIFIED

TEACHERS, PARENTS OR PARTICPANTS THAT ENGAGE WITH THE ADJUDICATOR PRIOR TO OR AFTER ANY PERFORMANCE DURING THE FESTIVAL WILL BE DISQUALIFIED

PERFORMERS

- Early arrival is recommended (10 minutes)
- Forbidden to use pianos and facilities before or between sessions
- . Must provide all music stands and other equipment (1 ORMTA music stand available at Christ Church)
- . Are responsible for providing original music and reclaiming it at the end of class

CHAIRPERSON

- Calls the participant for each class
- · Seats them in order
- Collects all original music to give to the adjudicator
- Calls upon each participant
- Assists the adjudicator with handouts and returns music to the student at the end of class

ADJUDICATOR

- Signals to the chairperson when ready for the next performer
- After each participant's performance takes time needed to write comments
- · Record marks on master sheet and certificate
- · Addresses participants as a group and/or individually
- Announces First, Second and Third placing
- Announces marks (at adjudicator's discretion)
- Provides each participant with written performance comments

SPECTATORS

- No admission after a session has commenced
- Cellular telephones, cameras, pagers, beepers, etc. <u>must be turned TO SILENT in the venue at all times</u>
- Cameras, tape and video recorders or other devices are not allowed
- Videotaping the adjudicator's comments is strictly prohibited
- . The Committee reserves the right to ask those not showing courtesy and respect to leave the venue

FESTIVAL ADJUDICATORS ARE CHOSEN FOR THEIR SKILL LEVEL AND ABILITY TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTIVE FEEDBACK. ADJUDICATORS ENCOURAGE, AFFIRM AND NURTURE THE STUDENT'S SKILL LEVEL, BUT CHALLENGE THE MORE PROFICIENT. DECISIONS ARE BASED SOLELY ON THE OPINIONS OF THE ADJUDICATOR AND ARE FINAL AND BINDING.

AWARDS

CYNTHIA ROVEDA MUSIC EDUCATION AWARD

This cash award of \$250.00 is given to a grade 12 high school student who is pursuing their studies, in the following school year, in music education in any discipline (ex., voice, piano, wind or string instrument) at a university or college level. This award is to encourage students to further their studies in music education at a university or college level and to become our future school music teachers. Please indicate a note 'pursuing music education' upon registration. (Subject to confirmation)

LYNDA REHDER KENNEDY PIANO AWARD

Since 2005, one piano student participating in the 2023 Festival is chosen by the adjudicator to receive this award of excellence. The \$250.00 cash award is sponsored by Neil Kennedy. (Subject to confirmation)

MULTI-DISCIPLINE AWARD

To be eligible, a participant must participate in at least two disciplines (i.e. voice and piano or piano and strings) one solo in at least two disciplines and one ensemble in at least one discipline. Example 1: piano solo and duet, violin solo. Example 2: voice solo, piano solo and concert band. Please indicate in notes when registering, if you would like to be considered for these awardS.

ALL AWARDS ARE TO BE DETERMINED

PIANO

- Choose music selections from the current or previous Syllabi of the Royal Conservatory of Music and Conservatory Canada. However, when a piece is listed in more than one grade level the current syllabus level must be used.
- Introductory Level refers to the introductory level/books of both conservatories (not a general beginner level)
- Beginner classes are meant for those students who are not yet in the Introductory Level books
- When selecting a Beginner class, chose the class that applies to both the age and the experience of the student
- Years of study for a Beginner are the total number of years, not the number of years with one teacher
